


## FUNDING FAMILIES FIRST!

Our fundraising team work very hard to keep Families First on the road! Our total budget for 2025-26 is set at £387,280, covering our three services, transport, volunteer recruitment, and administrative support. We have a diverse array of funders, from large national bodies to local groups and individuals and we are incredibly grateful to all of them!

## CORE FUNDERS

We are very lucky to hold major awards from the National Lottery Community Fund, the Bank of Scotland Enable Fund, the Alfred Dunhill Links Foundation, The Robertson Trust and Fife Council (where our Service Level Agreement for Befriending reflects our position as a respected service provider). These funds provide the backbone of our funding (42%), with multi-year awards particularly valuable for budget planning and security. We also hold many smaller grants which ensure the continuation of all our services.
